



Odometer Disclosure & Declaration

Odometers are the devices that keep track of the mileage on a vehicle.

Odometer readings are the actual numbers showing on the odometer. Dealers must disclose the mileage at the time of transfer of a vehicle and state whether the mileage seen is actual, not actual or in excess of its mechanical limits. Mark check boxes VERY CAREFULLY to avoid odometer discrepancies and be sure to indicate the date the mileage was read.

Keep in mind that neither dates, nor mileage go backwards. In addition, odometer readings do not go back and forth between "actual" and "in excess of its mechanical limits".

Six-digit odometers max out at 999,999 miles. Mileage that exceeds 999,999 will roll over and start over at 1. In these circumstances, mileage would exceed its mechanical limits.

Five-digit odometers max out at 99,999 miles. Mileage that exceeds 99,999 will roll over and start over at 1. In these circumstances, mileage would exceed its mechanical limits.

A six-digit odometer means that the device is **capable** of recording 6 digits. **It is not a six-digit READING.**

Odometer readings do not go back and forth between 5 and 6 digits.





Exempt from Odometer Disclosure

The following types of vehicles are exempt from the odometer disclosure:

- Any motor vehicle that is not self-propelled.
- Any motor vehicle that has a gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) of more than 16,000 pounds.
- Any new motor vehicle, covered by an MCO, transferred between dealers (dealer swaps). If you look at the MCO on the back, each reassignment section does not have all of the disclosure elements.
- Any motor vehicle that is 20 calendar years old or older.
- Any vehicle model year 2010 or older.



Odometer Disclosure Elements

The following are the elements included on an Odometer Disclosure:

- Current odometer reading
- Date odometer was read
- Certification by Transferor that odometer reading is one of the following:
 - Actual
 - Exceeds its mechanical limits
 - Not actual mileage,
- Transferor's Name and current address
- Transferee's Name and current address
- Signature and printed name of Transferor
- Signature and printed name of Transferee
- Vehicle Description (make, year, body type and VIN)

WHEN SHOULD THIS FORM BE USED?

1. WHEN A MOTOR VEHICLE, FOR WHICH AN ODOMETER DISCLOSURE IS REQUIRED, HAS BEEN SOLD.
2. WHEN A MOTOR VEHICLE, FOR WHICH AN ODOMETER DISCLOSURE IS REQUIRED, HAS BEEN PURCHASED.
3. WHEN AN ODOMETER DISCLOSURE STATEMENT AND ACKNOWLEDGMENT BETWEEN THE BUYER AND THE SELLER IS REQUIRED, BUT NO ODOMETER DISCLOSURE STATEMENT HAS BEEN MADE ON ANOTHER STATE OR FEDERAL FORM.

WHEN SHOULD THIS FORM NOT BE USED?

1. WHEN A FLORIDA TITLE WHICH WAS ISSUED ON OR AFTER APRIL 29, 1990 IS AVAILABLE.
2. WHEN A FORM HSMV 82994, MOTOR VEHICLE DEALER TITLE REASSIGNMENT SUPPLEMENT, HAS BEEN USED.
3. WHEN A FORM HSMV 82995, MOTOR VEHICLE DEALER POWER OF ATTORNEY/ODOMETER DISCLOSURE, HAS BEEN USED.
4. WHEN AN OUT-OF-STATE TITLE, WHICH CONFORMS TO FEDERAL LAW, IS USED TO TRANSFER A MOTOR VEHICLE.

FILING:

1. COPIES SHOULD BE EXCHANGED BETWEEN THE SELLER AND THE BUYER. DEALERS MUST RETAIN THIS DOCUMENT IN THEIR RECORDS FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE YEARS.
2. IT IS NOT NECESSARY TO FILE THIS FORM OR ANY COPY OF THIS FORM WITH THE STATE OF FLORIDA, UNLESS REQUESTED TO DO SO BY THE DIVISION OF MOTORIST SERVICES.

Odometer Disclosure & Declaration Requirements

Certificate of title applications and other related documents containing odometer disclosure or declaration forms or will be reviewed and examined for omissions, alterations and discrepancies.

Additional documentation is required for all corrections.

Omission – An omission is defined as omitting all or part of a required odometer reading on any odometer disclosure document where such information is required on the form, (ex: the date of reading, status certification, the signature, printed name, or address).

Alteration: Any strike over, erasure, ink-over, white-out or any other method of change made to an odometer disclosure statement required to be filed as part of a certificate of title application.

Discrepancy: An odometer reading which appears on a certificate of title or other documents submitted with application for title which is lower than previously recorded mileage.





Odometer Corrections

Documentation required to correct odometer omissions, alterations, and discrepancies:

Transfers occurring
from Dealer to Dealer
OR
Dealer to Retail Buyer

HSMV 82994, copy of an accurately completed Odometer Statement or a copy of an accurately completed HSMV 82993

AND

Letterhead affidavit signed by the Dealer explaining the error (required for alteration or discrepancy)

Transfers occurring
from Individual to
Individual
OR
Individual to Dealer

An original or a copy of an accurately completed HSMV 82993 showing the correction

AND

Affidavit signed by the Seller explaining the error (required for alteration or discrepancy)

NOTE: An affidavit is not required when the odometer reading was omitted, the odometer reading will need to be completed and the work, resubmitted.

SAMPLE

This form is often used to make corrections for an alteration or discrepancy on the odometer reading. It is an acknowledgement between buyer and seller that the information being recorded is correct.

Many dealerships complete form HSMV 82993 for every transaction in which mileage is recorded in case it is needed as backup documentation. Example: handwriting entered on the title is unclear. We cannot guess as to what was entered.

Without backup documentation it is necessary for us to reject the transactions for correction and supporting documentation.

If a dealer uses a non-secure POA to sign as buyer and seller, form HSMV 82993 is required to record mileage.



Odometer Disclosure & Declaration Requirements

On this slide you can see an alteration to the odometer reading that was presented.

Any reassignment with an alteration or discrepancy in the odometer disclosure area the application, must have supporting documents presented at the time of transfer.

Each person signing any odometer disclosure must sign and print their name.

If the odometer reading is not accurately completed and/or supporting documentation is not submitted for the error, the transaction will be rejected.

Odometer Disclosure & Declaration Requirements

The alteration in this example is for the sales tax collected. The Tax Collected has been lined through and altered to show a different amount.

The dealer would need to submit a notarized or perjury clause affidavit on their letterhead stating the amount of sales tax collected should be \$32.10.

The Odometer Disclosure Statement would **not** be required for this error because the odometer reading is complete, without discrepancies.

The dealer will be required to ensure that the sales tax amount collected on the title matches the sales tax collected on section 7 of HSMV 82040 Application for Title.
